### Water Wall

Beat the heat with your own water wall! Cut off the tops of plastic bottle, poke holes into the bottom of plastic containers, use funnels and more to experiment with water and gravity. Secure them with Velcro straps to a fence, deck rail, pegboard, or other structure. Watch what happens when the containers are moved around the wall!

As the communication partner, whether you are a family member, teacher, therapist or friend, use these words as you talk to model where they are located and how powerful they can be. Look for opportunities to teach and model these words while constructing and playing with your water wall. Make sure to keep your device away from direct water.
