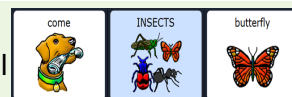

# LAMP Words For Life 84 Full Core Word Activity - Butterfly

Add the plural marker for plural form of the words



Have fun making and looking for butterflies this month! With a paper plate, glue, pipe cleaners, markers/paint, and decorations like stickers, sequins, gems, and tissue paper, you can make a simple butterfly. Cut the paper plate in half and fasten the halves together, facing the opposite direction. Fold a pipe cleaner in a U shape and attach under the plate for the antennae. Decorate! Practice making plural words by adding the plural s marker. Then take your butterfly outside to look for real ones! As the communication partner, whether you are a family member, teacher, therapist or friend, use these words as you talk to model where they are located and how powerful they can be. Look for opportunities to teach and model these words while making and looking for a butterfly this month!
